



Multimedia Show Tech Rider

Technical Requirements

- PA system with 8 or 9 channels on the board with an AUX input
- 2 vocal microphones
- 1 overhead microphone (for drums)
- 1 snare drum microphone
- 3 boom stands
- 2 DI boxes (guitar & bass amp)
- 3 monitors

Backline*

- 1 drum kit with bass drum, snare drum, hi-hat, cymbals and stool
- 1 bass amp
- In-house lighting
- 3 spotlights from above directed towards each musician Note: avoid the screens

Multimedia Show*

- 2 short-throw DLP rear projectors (minimum 3500 lumens) with HDMI inputs
- 2 x 25-foot HDMI cables
- 2 x 50-foot HDMI cables
- 2 x 9 x 16 foot 16:9 aspect ratio projection screens
- 2 x stereo ¼" AV cable connected for headphone mix for drum click track for drummer and bassist (artist supplies)
- 1 table and chair for tech station (set up on either side of the stage)

- 1 Sony Camera HDR-AS300 mounted on a tripod (artist supplies) to mount on a microphone stand (supplied by venue)
- 1 MacBook Pro laptop to operate the multimedia show (artist supplies)

*Notes: Band can provide bass amp and drum kit if already on tour so please confirm this with booking agent. The multimedia show can be done with one projection screen positioned behind the band with front projection. We can work with you to adapt the tech requirements to suit your theatre space.

Meals

- 2 vegan meals with no dairy, animals or animal by-products including butter, mayonnaise and eggs. Examples include vegetable sandwiches with hummus and whole wheat bread, vegetarian chilli, soup with vegetable broth, salads with oil and vinegar dressing.
- 1 meal without cow's dairy (goat's cheese, butter and Swiss or Lactose-free cow's cheese are fine)
- 1 meal without restrictions

Accommodation

- 3 non-smoking rooms (1 double, 2 single rooms with Queen beds)
- 3-4 stars within a 5-km radius of venue with complimentary breakfast, Wi-Fi, parking (or paid for by presenter), gym facilities, pool and hot tub
